2023 AGM RECORDS REPORT

Good day everyone,

What a great year, everyone is settling back to “normal” and we see the ladies and youngsters with great catches. “**All-Africa**” records are busy getting into place where we will again start getting the entire Africa involved with the help of IGFA. IGFA has established an IGFA Africa Region, and we now have an IGFA Africa Council. The first IGFA Africa Council meeting will take place on Saturday 22 April 2023, where I will be part as a member of the council. I will keep you posted regarding the way forward on the All Africa record processes.

I have also moved from Parys and now stay between Lanseria and Hartbeespoort. Please note the Postal address will change and I will distribute the new application forms with the updated address. I ask all Provincial Record’s Officers to then distribute the new form to all their Clubs and request the clubs to use the new format. Some records I received the last time was still on the “old” application forms.

Starting with Melchoir Wilmans, on 30 June 2022, Melchoir caught a huge Wahoo in St Lucia weighing 20.66kg using a 10kg line. This record is recorded as a SADSAA and All Africa Male-Junior Line Record. Well done Melchoir with this excellent achievement!

Josh Lingerfelder caught a Skipjack Tuna weighing 7.5kg on 8 October 2022. He caught the fish in Mapelane using a 10kg line and the excellent catch earned him a SADSAA and All Africa Male-Smallfry Line Record Line Record. Well done Josh with this great catch!

Diederick Johannes van der Linde caught a Skipjack Tuna weighing 9.65kg on 19 December 2022. He caught the fish in Barra Inhambane – Mozambique using a 15kg line and the excellent catch earned him an All Africa Male-Smallfry Line Record Line Record. Well done Diederick with this great catch!

Conrad Wasserman caught a Longfin Tuna weighing 8.95kg on 23 December 2022. He caught the fish in Hout Bay using a 10kg line and the excellent catch earned him a SADSAA and All Africa Male-Smallfry Line Record Line Record. Well done Conrad with this great catch!

Cheryl Wasserman caught a Yellowfin Tuna weighing 45.5kg on 23 December 2022. She caught the fish in Hout Bay using a 15kg line and the excellent catch earned her an All Africa Woman Line Record Line Record. Well done Cheryl with this great catch!
